

Donatella Boschi was born in Cossato on March 26th, 1964 and graduated in Pharmaceutical Chemistry (1989) and in Pharmacy (1993) from the University of Torino. In the same University she got the PhD degree in Drug Chemistry (1993). In 1993 she became Assistant Professor in Medicinal Chemistry at the Drug Science and Technology Department in Turin. Since 2001 she is Associated Professor of Pharmaceutical Analysis at the Faculty of Pharmacy of the University of Turin. Since 2001 she is a professor of the PhD course in Pharmaceutical Sciences at the Doctorate School of Science and High Technology of the University of Torino. The scientific activity is in the field of drug design and mainly concerns the study of NO-donors and NO-donor polyvalent agents as potential drugs for the treatment of cardiovascular diseases. Recently she studied the synthesis and the pharmacological activity of new anti-inflammatory NO donor derivatives.
